**Title:**

From Data to Publication and Back

**Description:**

This satellite meeting is intended as a small, discussion-focused session for participants interested in connecting active research data workflows with repository-based publication.

Many teams still experience friction when moving data between computational environments (e.g. HPC, notebooks, pipelines) and repository platforms: manual transfers, duplicated storage, and disconnected metadata practices. At the same time, there is growing interest in making data more interoperable, reusable, and “AI-ready” across systems.

The session will begin with a brief introduction outlining the research data lifecycle — from data collection and processing through analysis, publication, and subsequent reuse — providing a shared context for an open discussion.

Participants are invited to share their own experiences, challenges, and ideas related to:

- active data management vs. deposition and publication: challenges and requirements
- interoperability between repositories and external platforms
- integrating compute environments with data publication workflows
- reuse of research outputs in practice
- handling distributed or large-scale datasets
- enabling reproducible and reusable research workflows

The goal is to bring together practitioners working on similar problems, exchange practical insights, and identify common directions or potential collaborations.

The session is open to anyone interested in these topics, regardless of their level of experience with Dataverse or specific tools.

90–180 minutes (flexible, depending on participants’ interest and engagement)
